## **IMPORTATION GUIDELINES FOR APPLICANTS**

Heavy Equipment as defined in the customs schedule:

- 1. Self-propelled
  - o bulldozers
  - angle dozers, graders, levelers, scrapers and other earth movers;
    mechanical shovels, excavators and shovel loaders;
    tamping machines and road rollers; and
    backhoes.
- 2. Extracting or boring machinery;
- 3. Pile drivers and pile extractors
- 4. Cranes
- 5. Cement or concrete batching equipment or plant.
- 6. Tractors.
- 7. (1) Vehicles not constructed or adapted for use on roads.
  - (2) Trucks, including -
    - trucks constructed or adapted for the maintenance of roads;
    - cement or concrete mixing or pumping trucks;
    - crane trucks
    - work trucks constructed or adapted for the carriage or haulage of ten or more tons of goods or burden or any description, or a trailer so constructed or adapted; and
    - mobile drilling derricks.
